WHERE:

Sanitary District No. 2 located at 2090 Grand Avenue in Baldwin. (One traffic light North of Sunrise Highway.) Enter off of Baldwin Avenue

WHY:

Unused prescriptions and/or over-the-counter medications are dangerous to other family members and dangerous to the environment if disposed of improperly.

Operation Shed the Meds will:

- Dispose of drugs in an environmentally-safe manner,
- Help prevent seniors, children, and others from ingesting these medications
