Items Accepted at S.T.O.P.

Aerosol Cans, Ammonia, Antifreeze, Asbestos (Double Bagged), Car/Household Batteries, Bleach, Bug & Rodent Killers, Chemistry Sets, Degreasers, Disinfectants, Drain Cleaners, Fertilizers with Herbicides, Fire Extinguishers (One Time Use), Flammable Liquids (*Fire Starter, Gasoline, & Diesel Fuel*) *Fluorescent Lamps & CFL's in shatterproof containers including ballasts*, Kerosene, Lacquers, Latex & Oil-Based, Paints, Oven Cleaners, Paint, Strippers, Paint Thinners & Brush, Cleaners, Pesticides, Photography Chemicals, Polishes & Wood, Preservatives, Propane Tanks (20lbs), Solvents, Spot Removers, Swimming Pool Chemicals, Telephone Books, Thermostats (Containing Mercury), Tires (Car - Off Rims), Varnish, Waste Oil, Weed Killers

Items NOT Accepted at S.T.O.P.

Ammunition, Electronic Recyclable Waste, Explosives, Fire Extinguishers, Commercial Fireworks, Infectious or Medical Waste, Sharps, Medications, Oxygen Tanks, Propane Tanks (Larger than 20 lbs), Radioactive Materials, Unlabeled Materials
