

Commissioner DeHaney put forth the following RESOLUTION and moved for its adoption:

RESOLVED: Sanitary District No. 2 is required to hold an annual election, in accordance with the Nassau County Civil Divisions Act, on the last Thursday in July of each year for the purpose of electing a Sanitation Commissioner for a five (5) year term.

RESOLVED: That such election was set to be held on Thursday, July 30, 2020 from 2:00 p.m. till 10:00 p.m. in accordance with the Nassau County Civil Divisions Act.

RESOLVED: That the Governor of New York State issued Executive Order No. 202 on March 7, 2020 declaring a State disaster emergency for the entire State of New York and that such Executive Order shall be in effect until September 7, 2020.

RESOLVED: That the Governor of New York State issued numerous Executive Orders, and that Executive Order 202-44, issued on June 21, 2020, has addressed the issue of elections in the following:

*Any district or special district, including, but not limited to fire, library, sewer, or water, that conducts an election and/or budget vote shall be rescheduled for September 15, 2020 and collection of signatures for nominating petitions hereby suspended until further notice, subject to a process determined by a future Executive Order; provided however, a library district may conduct an election on June 9, 2020 pursuant to this Executive Order is such election is managed by a school district.*

RESOLVED: That an elected Commissioner whose term was set to expire at midnight on July 31, 2020, shall remain in such position until such time as an election can be held in accordance with New York State Governor Executive Orders.

RESOLVED: That therefore, the Board of Commissioners of Sanitary District No. 2 have determined that not foregoing any additional Executive Orders, the District shall conduct the election on Tuesday, September 15, 2020 from 2:00 p.m. till 10:00 p.m.
